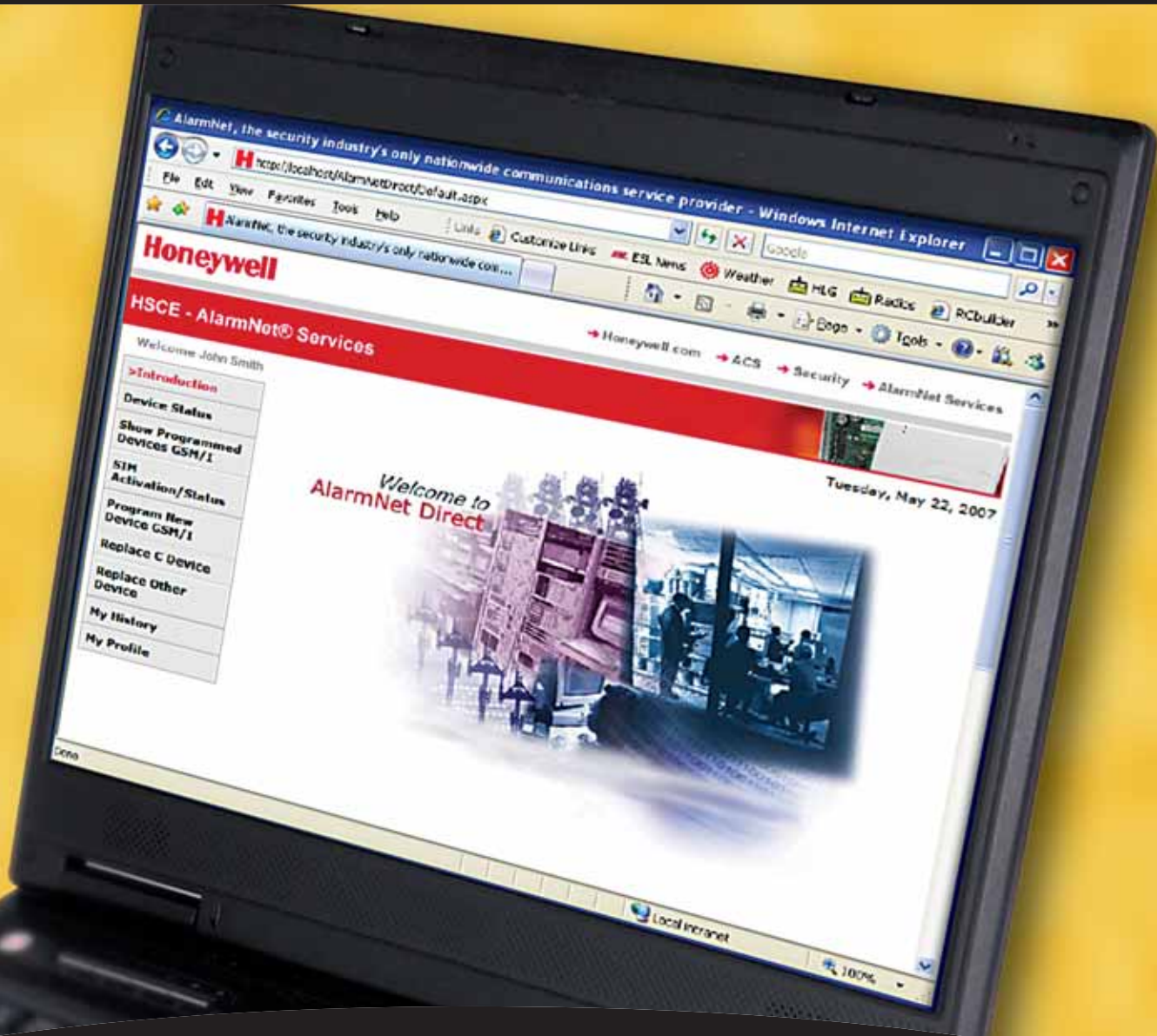

Select from a full menu of online programming features and account management options.

Device Status

Register/check status of device with AlarmNet.

Show Programmed Devices GSM/I

Displays all devices by account number, MAC ID and device type. “Actions” allows you to edit information, upload and download data, test, or delete the device.

SIM Activation/Status

Register device with the carrier, check status of the carrier’s connection. Activate the device with the carrier: MAC and CRC numbers are provided with the GSM device. Enter these numbers into the AlarmNet site to activate the carrier’s service with just a few entries. You will receive an e-mail from AlarmNet confirming the SIM activation within a short period of time.

Program New Device GSM/I

With just a few entries and the click of a button, new devices are programmed (ECP connection and standard supervision). “Advanced Programming” allows for non-standard installation.

Replace C Device

By entering key account information along with the MAC ID of the new device, programming replacement radios couldn’t be easier.

Replace Other Device

Simple entry of device ID’s along with the GSM/I MAC ID makes this task a snap.
